In 2012 she was awarded the Gertrude Aston Bowater scholarship for practice-led PhD research based at the Centre for Fine Art Research, Birmingham School of Art and in 2013 she received the T.G Hamilton research Grant from the University of Manitoba, Canada, to work with the supernatural photographic archive of Thomas Glendenning Hamilton.

Grace is Arts Editor for the International Journal for Fine Art, Philosophy & the Wild Sciences 'Zētēsis' published through ARTicle press for which she is also an editorial board member.
