

# Harry Meadows

## Biography

Harry Meadows is an artist and educator. His research focuses on methods for visualising social relations. Since gaining an AHRC award and completing an MFA at Goldsmiths College he has exhibited with institutions such as The Barbican, Southbank Centre and Hayward Touring, as well as commissions for the Whitstable Biennial, Supernormal Festival and Black Maria at The Granary, Kings Cross. Participatory projects include Coracle Regatta, an annual event on the edge of the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park 2006 – 2012 and Slow Bike Race at Pump House Gallery, Battersea 2012.

Harry has worked as artist in residence at London Metropolitan University, Brazier's Park, Studio36 Spike Island and The Observatory. He currently works at Arts University Bournemouth, where he is senior lecturer in Fine Art.
